World Work and the Psychology of Power: World Work Training and Experience

with Dr. Arny Mindell and certified teachers of process work

Global conflict resolution begins to the extent each of us increases our awareness, deepens inner peace, and courageously brings forth rightful eldership. The idea that the whole world is within each of us is no longer simply a transpersonal or archetypal belief. It is an absolute political necessity.

This third world work seminar will provide a unique opportunity for people from all over the world to come together in a powerful forum for focusing on and working with social, environmental, and political issues using group process work skills.

Group process work presents methods for facilitating groups at every level of interaction. Participants will be working on issues and learning skills applicable to individuals, relationships, sub-groups and the large group.

These 10 days will consist of training and experience in large group settings where a variety of issues relevant to the group and the world scene will be processed. Small groups of 10 will meet daily to further practice specific training exercises in abuse work, racism, conflict resolution and facilitation. Group process work recognizes that relationship work and inner work are important aspects of any kind of group work; therefore, participants who wish to may attend private one to one sessions to focus on individual issues that may arise. These are included in the price of tuition. Special interest groups will have an opportunity for coalition building and networking.

The main language of the course will be english and we recognize that this is a great privilege for many of us who will be participating. Please inform us of your language needs.

The organization works hard to make this workshop a diverse group in terms of nationality, race, gender, class, sexual orientation and religion. We appreciate your help in networking with various groups who you feel need more representation.

Dates: Begins July 5, 1993 at 9:30am and ends July 16th at 12 noon. July 10th and 11th will be free unscheduled days. No meals will be planned during this time.

Discipline, Awareness and Certification in World Work

with Drs. Arny and Amy Mindell

This intensive week is for those who have already attended at least one worldwork seminar, and is devoted to getting deeper into the mysteries of worldwork, unravelling personal abilities and wakefulness in the trance states induced by difficult group situations. We shall be working on consciousness of abuse, privilege and environment, and the ability to use these concepts together with signal awareness and group roles during normal and extreme group situations. Methods for working with racism and terrorism shall evolve.

The number of group participants will be more limited than during the worldwork seminar which precedes this one, and geared towards certification in worldwork. Through challenging each other under peaceful circumstances, we hope to arrive at greater awareness in adverse times. Training, supervision and applications in an atmosphere of both rigor and support will bring out inherent eldership. Those involved in the certification process will get personal and group feedback for their work.

Dates: Begins July 18, 1993 at 8pm (7pm if you have signed up for dinners) ends July 23rd at 12 noon.

WORLD WORK SCHOLARSHIP POLICY AND OUTREACH

The world work seminar offers as many scholarships as it can and appreciates the many people who contribute funds to help with the huge expense of paying for travel and lodging. If you feel you can afford to add a little extra money to your tuition you will be helping to make the group more diverse. Please write a separate check made out to "Scholarship Fund" and send it to the same address.

The world work seminar recognizes that there are two types of applicants: People coming from countries where the currency is not equivalent to the U.S. dollar are encouraged to apply for a scholarship in addition to travel and living costs, if needed. Please send a letter stating your financial need. These scholarships are awarded immediately as long as we have funds.

People coming from western countries or from places where there is a fair equivalency who need help with tuition are also invited to apply for a quarter or half tuition scholarship. Since scholarships are awarded on basis of need, please provide a brief description of your financial situation. Scholarship recipients will be chosen by lot by March 1, 1993.

We ask all scholarship recipients to contribute to the organizational workload. If you have special skills, such as video, sound technician, etc. please let us know. We also ask scholarship recipients to be available a day before and after the seminar for help with registration and clean up.

LAVA ROCK DREAMBODY CLINICS Living Eternity Now: Disease, Lifestyle and Personal History

with Dr. Max Schuepbach, Dr. Arnold Mindell and a staff of certified process workers

If you are afflicted by a serious illness, are yearning for an environment that supports you in going deeply into your experiences, and that helps you in your struggles around life, death and the possibility of eternity--if you have the humor and love to connect you to the awe of every moment in your life, even those moments that seem miserable--we would like to invite you to these bi-annual residential seminars that focus on physical illness and the dreaming process behind illness.

Process Work with body symptoms and disease is based on the idea that there is a patterned and meaningful flow of life behind illness, which can be accessed and unfolded by following body experiences. Symptoms and disease are direct expressions of these deeper patterns and can be worked with in a holistic way by helping bring forth processes that connect the individual to the meaning of his or her life and long-term life tasks. Through this a whole dreaming process unfolds, not only around the individual, but in connection to relationships and the world at large. This larger network or pattern can be experienced as the web we are and live in.

LAVA ROCK CLINICS take place twice a year on the Oregon Coast. The seminars provide an opportunity for exploring and learning in depth about symptoms and illness on both a group and personal level. Large and small group work is alternated with optional individual private sessions with staff members. The clinic combines personal experiential work for people with chronic symptoms, their family members, triends and caretakers, with training aspects for those in the medical and therapeutic professions. Psychosomatic medicine, personal growth and creativity, community building, worldwork and research, as well as the option of medical consultations are integrated in this framework of process-oriented medicine.

THE LAVA ROCK CLINIC NETWORK is the larger community around the individual. It helps to create and sustain support groups and connects you, if you wish, with Process Workers and medical doctors in your area. It publishes a newsletter and coordinates training and research. We believe the community feeling that is created during the seminar has a healing effect. The support of a community in sustaining new patterns is crucial. We try to support this community feeling by making your return to these clinics as economical as possible. The second time you participate in The Lava Rock Clinics you pay 3/4 of the price; the third clinic is half price.

Spring Clinic

Living Eternity Now: Disease Lifestyle and Personal History

Dates: Begins March 28, 1993 at 8pm (7pm for those who sign up for dinner) and ends on April 9th at 1pm. Saturday and Sunday April 3rd and 4th are free unscheduled days.

Tuition: \$800.00 or \$1100.00 with 5 therapy sessions

Fall Clinic

Dates: Begins on Sept. 12, 1993 at 8pm (7pm for those who sign up for dinners) and ends on Sept. 17th at 1pm.

Tuition: \$400.00 or \$520.00 with 2 therapy sessions or \$580.00 with 3 therapy sessions.

Scholarship Policy: Some scholarships are available for those who are ill. Work Scholarships are also available for those who are not ill but would like to attend the clinic. In this case work responsibilities will be related to the size of the scholarship. Please apply by writing a letter stating your financial need and your abilities to help with organizational responsibilities. Please mention if you have video or technical talents. Scholarships will be chosen by lot in mid January 1993 for the Spring clinic and by June 1st for the Fall.

These seminars are an educational experience, intended to enhance personal growth. We strongly encourage participants to attend these seminars with their physician's or therapist's approval.

Extreme States Clinic: Psychiatry, Personal Growth and Social Change

with Dr. Arnold Mindell, Dr. George McCouch and Dr. Joseph Goodbread and a certified staff of process workers

Over the years, extreme states of consciousness and psychiatric emergencies have been successfully viewed and treated using biomedical and causal models. The medical approach, by helping us to cope with the most disabling symptoms, has given us increasing freedom to explore the meaning and purposefulness which we sense is trying to emerge through these extreme states.

Process Work offers a conceptual framework as well as a set of therapeutic tools for helping to unfold these states and to make their message accessible not only to the individual, but also to the society of which he or she is a part. In this five-day workshop, we will emphasize training in the Process Work approach to extreme states of consciousness. This workshop is meant for psychiatrists, mental health professionals, therapists, social workers, and anyone interested in learning to work effectively with themselves and others in extreme and altered states of consciousness.

The workshop format will include work with individuals in the large group, work in small groups to explore personal experience and practice interventions, as well as daily review sessions in which we will study the day's experiential work to deepen our understanding and discuss alternative interventions. Participants will also have the opportunity to attend a couple of private one to one sessions which are included in the price of tuition.

Dates: Begins Sept. 19, 1993 at 8pm (7pm if you have signed up for dinners) and ends Sept. 24th at noon.

Tuition: \$400.00

Scholarship Policy: A limited number of work-study scholarships are available. Please apply by writing a letter stating your financial need and your abilities to help with organizational responsibilities. Please mention if you have video or technical talents. Scholarships will be chosen by lot by June 1st, 1993.

Logistics and Enrollment Information

Location: Waldport, Oregon, USA. Waldport is a small town situated on the scenic Oregon coast, home to seals, sea lions and whales. The venue is on the Alcea Bay adjacent to miles of uninterrupted beach on the dramatic Pacific Ocean.

Accomodations: All courses will take place at the Quality Inn at the Bayshore in Waldport, Oregon. Please make your own room reservations directly with the Quality Inn, tel. 1-800-526-9586, or if you are calling from outside of the U.S., (503) 563-3202. Please indicate your roommate preference; if you would like a roommate and don't know anyone, the Quality Inn will be happy to assist you. Tell them if you have any special roommate considerations.

Room Rates: Remember to inform the hotel that you are part of the seminar group and to ask for the following special rates.

If there are more than 2 people in a room there is an additional cost of \$5, for each person.

Meals: Group breakfasts and dinners will be available at the Quality Inn. Breakfasts are simple with cereals, breads, muffins, fruit and beverages and cost \$3.95 per breakfast. Dinners are mostly vegetarian with some chicken and fish, always include salad and cost \$7.50 each. There are many restaurants in town and there is a restaurant at the hotel for lunches. Meals will not be served during the free, unscheduled weekends of the longer seminars.

Continuing Education Credit: There is a possibility that continuing education credit will be available for the two World Work seminars through the Peace Studies Department at The University of Oregon. The University will charge a small fee per credit. Please inquire if you would be interested.

Cancellation Policy: The tuition is non-refundable. However, we will return a percentage of the tuition if your place can be filled.
