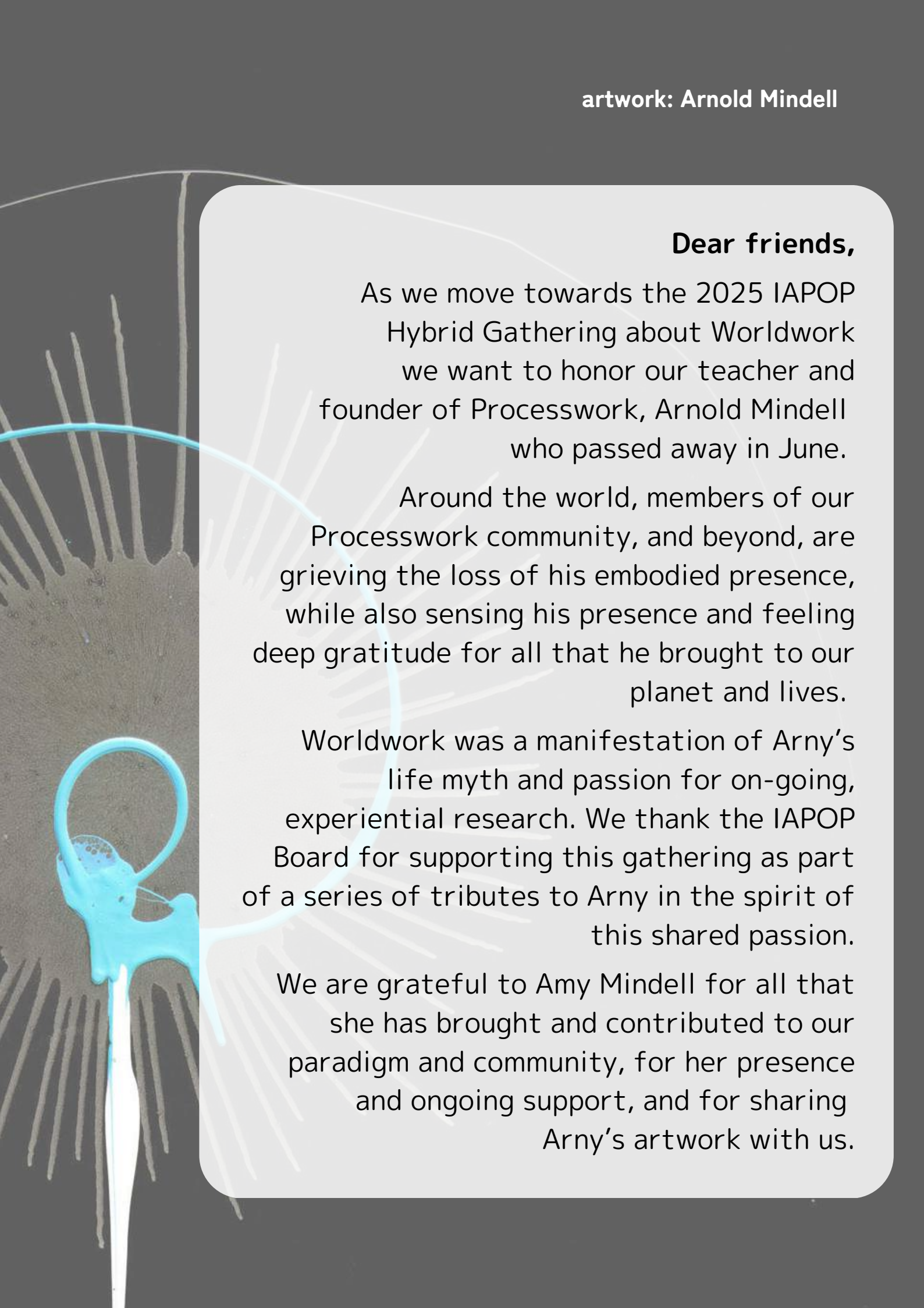

[Participation Fee]

80 euros for in-person and on-line participation

We have tried to keep costs to a minimum, and IAPOP is supporting the event covering around half of the expenses, yet still, a participation fee is necessary in order to cover the expenses.

We will share the budget at the meeting.

Please pay the full participation fee to help cover the costs of the meeting, regardless of the hours you plan on attending online. Thank you.

[Accommodation]

We have negotiated with the hotel lower rates for our group:

Single room with Half Board - 150 EUR /per room

- Breakfast + Lunch or Dinner
- 140+10 euros climate tax

Double room with Half Board - 160 EUR /per room

- Breakfast + Lunch or Dinner
- 150+10 euros climate tax

Rates for Children:

- 1st child for free (Room + Breakfast + Lunch or Dinner)
- 2nd child 15 euros/day (Room + Breakfast + Lunch or Dinner)

The special rates for our group will be available **until Saturday March 15, 2025. Please make your reservations by that date.**

Please Note: In our effort to keep the costs as low as possible, we have been able to negotiate with the hotel the agreement to get the large meeting room for free with the commitment that the people participating in person will stay in the hotel. It is important that **as a community we honor this agreement** that we have made with the hotel. Thank you for helping us with this.



[Roommates]

If you will stay in a Double/Twin room, one of the two people staying in that room needs to book the hotel, pay the deposit, and list the name of the roommate during booking.

[Hotel Reservation]

[Travel to the Venue]

Public Transportation

The hotel can be reached by train up to Corinth by taking the A2 line up to Ano Liosia (35 min ride) and then switching to the A4 line toward Kiato and getting off at the Corinth station (1 hour 5 min ride), and then a 25 minute taxi drive from Corinth train station to the hotel.

Taxi or Minivan

We have arranged for special rates for taxi or minivan - depending on the number of people traveling together - from the airport to the hotel in Loutraki:

RATES for flight arrivals from 4.30 to 22.30

Taxi - 1 to 4 people - 130 euros *

Minivan - 5 to 7 people - 170 euros*

*1 suitcase for each person

RATES for flight arrivals from 22.30 to 4.30

Taxi - 1 to 4 people - 160 euros *

Minivan - 5 to 7 people - 200 euros*

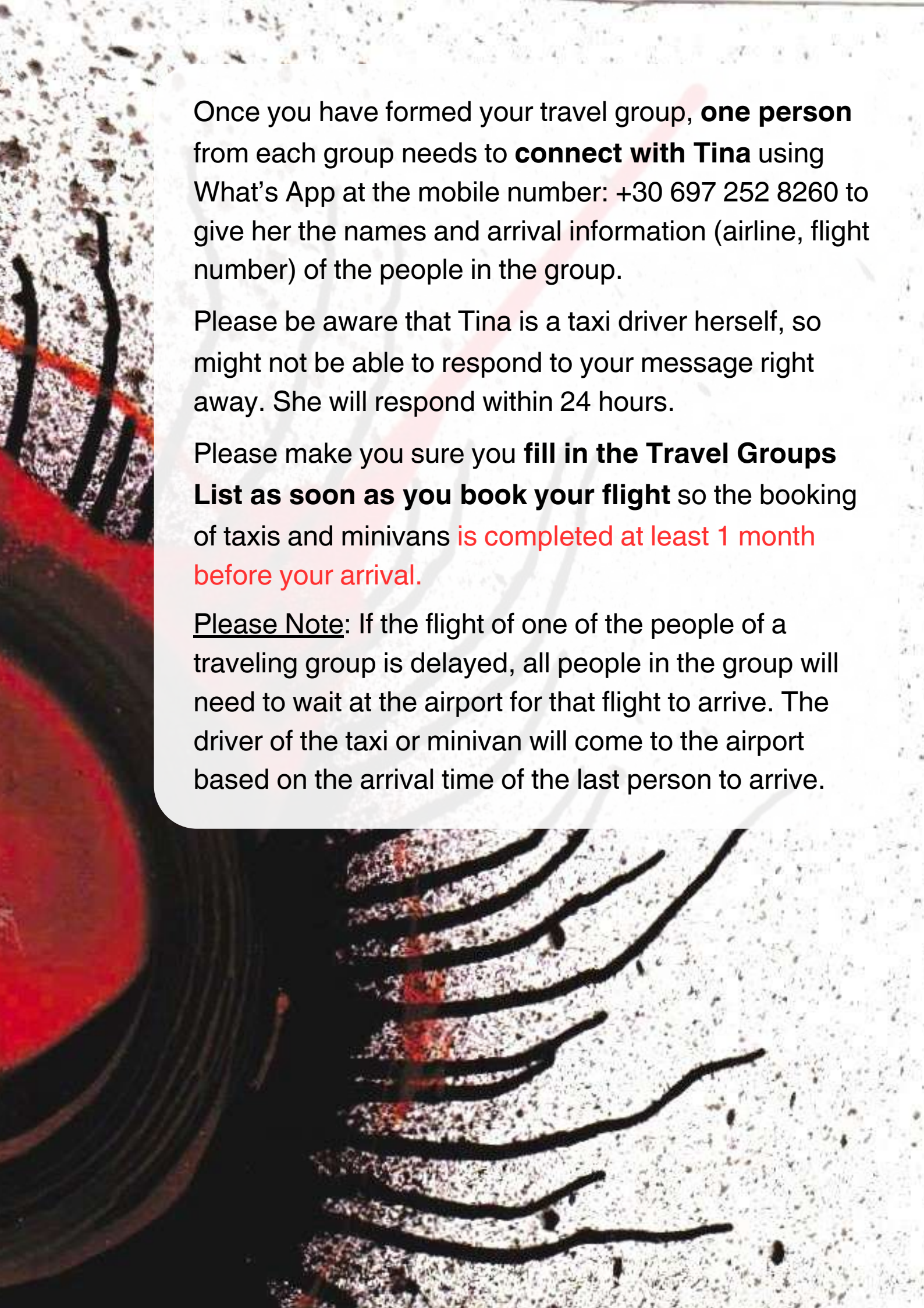

Once you have formed your travel group, **one person** from each group needs to **connect with Tina** using What's App at the mobile number: +30 697 252 8260 to give her the names and arrival information (airline, flight number) of the people in the group.

Please be aware that Tina is a taxi driver herself, so might not be able to respond to your message right away. She will respond within 24 hours.

Please make you sure you **fill in the Travel Groups List as soon as you book your flight** so the booking of taxis and minivans **is completed at least 1 month before your arrival.**

Please Note: If the flight of one of the people of a traveling group is delayed, all people in the group will need to wait at the airport for that flight to arrive. The driver of the taxi or minivan will come to the airport based on the arrival time of the last person to arrive.

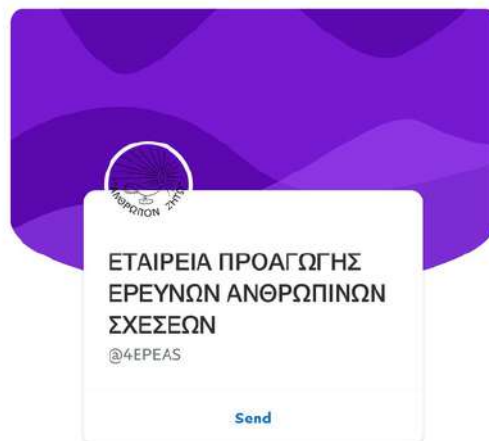

INFORMATION ABOUT THE PURPOSE & FORMAT OF THE EVENT

[Purpose]

We are gathering to meet, interact and commune with ourselves, each other, nature, the spirits of the land, the spirit of worldwork, the forces that move and organise us, both individually and collectively, and in this way use ourselves to research, learn and co-evolve our Worldwork methodology and its application.

[Focus Areas & How We Envision Working Together]

1. **Present the harvested feedback:** We have completed the feedback process that was done through the invitation we extended to hold local meetings to gather feedback, or to meet with us individually for this purpose. We will present a harvest of this feedback at our meeting, which will include the hotspots felt and identified by members of our international community.
2. **Process hot spots** - We will focus on hotspots that are present between us in the community as indicated in the harvested feedback, and as they appear in the moment.



3. **Action Research** - We will focus on, and learn from our experiences in the moment, as we process the hot spots.

Meaning, when we reach a point of great escalation, or sense of being stuck or marginalisation, or feelings of rage, hurt or hopelessness, we will slow down and explore our experiences of being facilitated, what feels good, what doesn't feel good, what we need, etc.

We will study ourselves in terms of the personal development needed as both facilitators and participant facilitators.

We will also study the interventions we use, and harvest good practices we may be already applying in our work, brainstorming and sensing to discern together possible evolution.

[Finances]

- This is a community meeting supported financially by the IAPOP budget and a minimal participation fee. No one is benefiting financially.
- The only work that is paid is logistic work done by the Organising Team with a minimal symbolic amount. Most of the organizing work is done on a pro-bono basis as an offering to our community.
- Facilitation will be done on a pro-bono basis. Our frame is: We are colleagues gathering, each offering what we have to offer.
- We had formed a consortium of organizations in five European Union countries (Spain, Czech Republic, Greece, Poland, and Slovakia, with Spain leading the consortium) and applied for EU Funding through an Erasmus+ program to raise funds to cover some of the costs. Unfortunately we did not receive this grant.
- **We are looking for ways to support** people who want to participate in person but cannot afford to cover the expenses, and to **hold this conversation together collectively as a community**, both the ones who can afford and the ones who cannot afford to cover the expenses, so **we will be in touch with you all again**, once we have a sense of the needs that are present in order **to find a way collectively** to address them.

To begin this process:

- If you want to participate in person and **cannot afford it**, please fill in the registration form and note your need for financial support, and we will connect with you.
- If you want **to support** the event, whether you will attend or not, please fill in the registration form noting that you want to help support others to attend, and we will connect with you.

[People Invited to the Event & Community Engagement]

Due to the endeavor's complexity, **we are limiting participation** in this first attempt at such a gathering to all current IAPOP members, as well as, all graduates for whom membership is available, as noted on the IAPOP website: “graduates of PW Diploma, DDI Diploma, MPW, MACF, MAPOF programs.”

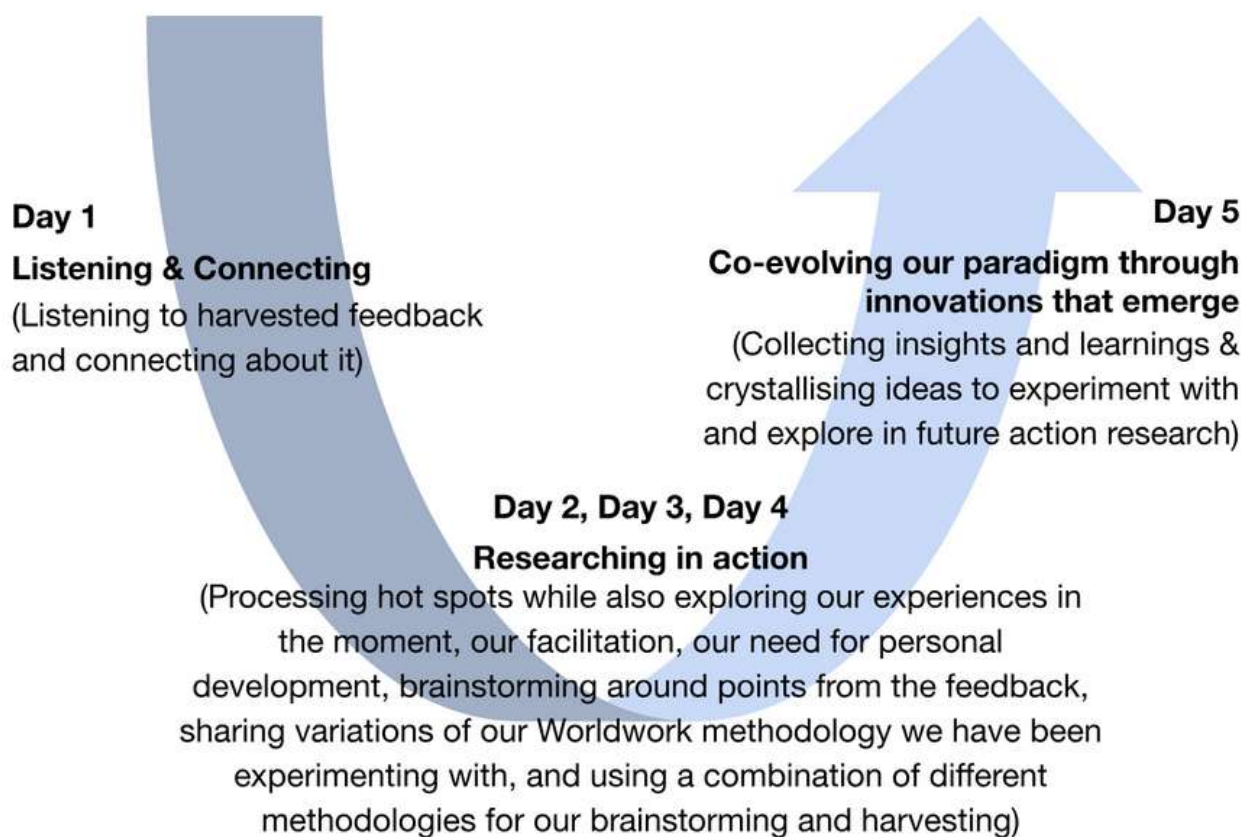
We have made a commitment as Organizing Team to reciprocate by sharing all learnings, ideas and outcomes from the meeting with everyone who took part in these local meetings.

Below is a diagram of a **broad overview** of our gathering:



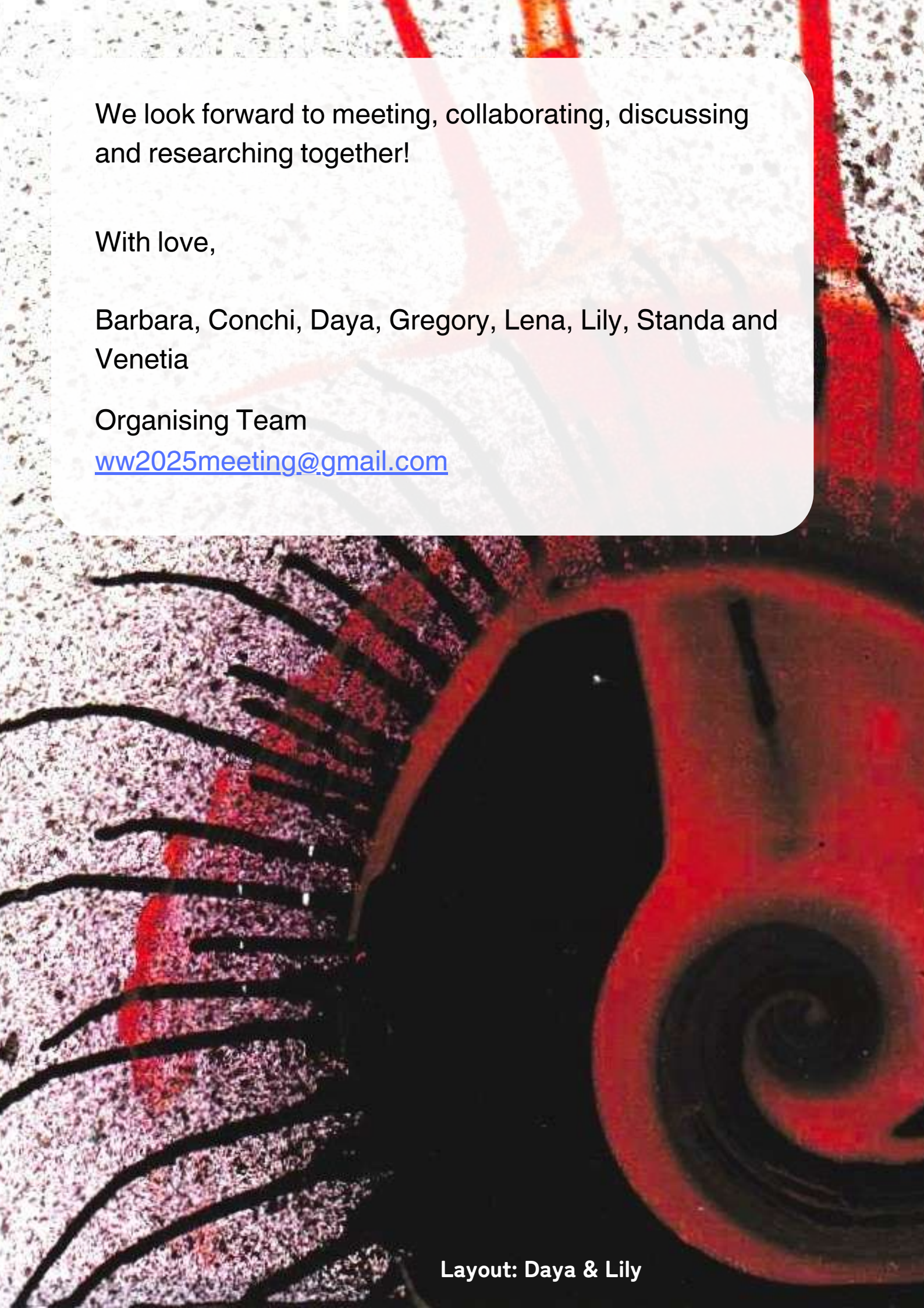


[Organising Team's Next Focus Areas]
